The Province of West Yorkshire Mark Master Masons Social Committee invite you to enjoy a weekend in Scotland's capital city Edinburgh.

Edinburgh is one of the most popular and cultural destinations in Europe with a thriving arts scene, a good wash of museums and galleries, an Old and New Town ensemble which have earned the city an 'Athens of the North' nickname and World Heritage acclaim. Edinburgh's foot friendly compactness means that it can easily be explored by walking. The famous Royal Mile is a network of roads that feature a high concentration of places of interest as well as linking the centrepiece Castle with Holyrood House Palace, the Scottish residence of Her Majesty the Queen. When the Queen is not in residence, the Palace's grandeur and history, that is heavily linked to Mary, Queen of Scots, can be appreciated by a guided tour. The Royal Yacht Britannia is also worth a visit.

Our chosen hotel is the Best Western King's Manor Hotel, a family owned and run hotel just 3 miles on the eastern side of the centre of Edinburgh yet only a short walk to the beach at Portobello. The hotel enjoys an excellent reputation for its hospitality and quality of its food whilst the leisure club, with a 20 metre pool and beauty salon, has added to the hotels popularity.

### Proposed Itinerary

**Friday**—Morning departure heading north to Edinburgh—perhaps you may wish to arrange a visit to the Grand Lodge of Scotland this afternoon prior to arriving at our hotel with time to relax before evening dinner.

**Saturday**—This morning, perhaps you would like to visit Rosslyn Chapel, already well known for its superb Masonic carvings but now also world famous thanks to the Da Vinci Code. The afternoon could be free to enjoy Edinburgh's city centre.

**Sunday**—Perhaps you may wish to visit the former Royal Yacht Britannia which played a huge part in the lives of our beloved Royal Family. We depart for home early afternoon arriving in our local areas early evening.

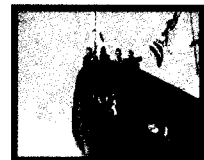
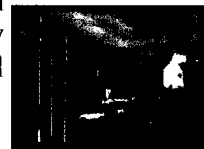
